88th Annual Meeting Update

Cinfed hosted its 88th annual meeting on June 7 at the Oakley headquarters office. CEO Jay Sigler reported the 2021 financial results, reflecting another strong year for the organization. Assets grew to \$675 million, the second consecutive year of record growth, and net income for 2021 was \$6.8 million, another strong figure that surpassed budget expectations.

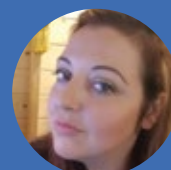
